Resolution of the Joint Selection Committee regarding the financing of joint research projects under the framework of the Polish-Swiss Research Programme

On February 9th and 10th, 2012, during its fourth meeting, the Joint Selection Committee selected the Joint Research Projects from the reserve list that will be financed under the Polish Swiss Research Programme.

The Committee members based their decision on the following rules and criteria according to the provisions of Operational Programme:

- assessment of the peer reviews.
- assessment of the projects by the JSC members.
- available funds in total amount of 18.7 Mio PLN.
- an adequate distribution, according to the entered applications, between the different thematic areas.

In general, the Committee very much appreciated the high quality of the 16 analyzed proposals from the reserve list.

The following projects are selected:
